POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Welcome to **Kids Club!** We're glad you are participating this year. Our goal is to provide a fun and creative activity for kids in a safe and healthy environment. For this reason we have adopted the following policies and procedures. When you sign the Kids Club Registration form, you agree to abide by these policies and procedures.

Wellness Policy:

Kids must be free of these symptoms for at least **48 hours** prior to attending Kids Club: fever of 100+ degrees, vomiting, diarrhea, contagious skin infections, or other contagious diseases (pink eye, etc.) If a kid appears to be sick while at Kids Club, we call the parent to pick-up the kid.

Medicine Policy:

We **do not administer** medicine or drugs to kids. If a kid needs to take medicine during Kids Club, the parent must be responsible for this.

Safety Policy:

Kids must abide by **Calvary Kids House Rules**. (see other side)

Supervision Policy

While at Calvary Community Church, kids must be supervised at all times by their parent, the Kids Club leaders, or the KidCare staff.

Arrival Procedure:

For safety, **every kid must be escorted into the building** by an adult and taken to their Kids Club room. If you arrive before **7:00 p.m.** you must supervise your child until Kids Club doors open.

Dismissal Procedure:

For safety, **every kid must be signed-out by an adult** from Kids Club or KidCare. Kids are **only released to parents or adults authorized on the Kids Club Registration form**.
